

Information regarding the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU

WayCon Positionsmesstechnik GmbH hereby comments on the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) and the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (ElektroG) as national implementation of the EU requirements.

Scope of application

- WayCon products are not electrical or electronic devices within the meaning of WEEE.
- They are sold exclusively in the B2B sector and not to private end users (B2C).
- They do not represent independently functioning components for control or regulation, but serve as precise measuring sensors in customer-specific systems.
- They do not fall into categories 1 to 6 of Annexes I-IV of the WEEE Directive.

Service for manufacturers of electrical and electronic appliances

- On request, WayCon products can be labelled in accordance with Annex IX (waste garbage can symbol).
- Manufacturers who use WayCon sensors in their own WEEE-compliant devices are supported in terms of the regulation.
- The responsibility for the timely registration and notification of their products in terms of WEEE remains with the respective manufacturer.

WayCon Positionsmesstechnik GmbH continuously monitors changes in the scope and content of the WEEE Directive and the ElektroG. Internal guidelines and processes are adapted as necessary to ensure consistent compliance with the directives. In addition, the interpretation and interpretation of the regulations continue to be monitored. Electronic waste from our own business areas is disposed of properly in accordance with legal requirements.
